Jenis penelitian ini adalah studi kasus. Pengumpulan data dilakukan dengan teknik survei, wawancara, dokumentasi. Penelitian ini menggunakan data primer yang berupa hasil wawancara dan kuesioner. Data sekunder yang berupa peraturan-peraturan yang terdapat di website resmi PT. GO-JEK. Kuesioner diberikan kepada 60 driver GO-JEK. Metode analisis data yang digunakan adalah metode deskriptif komparatif. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa pendapatan bersih yang diterima driver GO-JEK *fulltime* berada di atas UMR yang berlaku di Kota Yogyakarta.
