

ABSTRACT

This study analyzes one of Emily Dickinson's poems entitled *I died for beauty, but was scarce*, which is a mourning poem about death. The aim of this study is to find the personification of death and the meaning of the whole personification in *I died for beauty, but was scarce* poem. In this study, the researcher formulated two research questions, namely: "What death personification can be found in I died for beauty, but was scarce poem?" and "What is the meaning of the whole death personification found in I died for beauty, but was scarce poem?"

In collecting the data, the researcher employed library research. The formalist approach would be suitable to analyze the problems along with other theories. The researcher used two sources in the study. The primary source is *I died for beauty, but was scarce* poem. The secondary sources are taken from related books, journals, and internet sources. The theories of personification are applied in this study.

Based on the analysis, death is personified as corpses that are having the ability like a living human who is having consciousness. The meaning of the whole death personification is that when people who try to pursue something during their life, however after they died, they will be forgotten. Indeed, someone who died will be remembered for a while by relatives, family, or people who recognize him. However, at the end of the day, they will be forgotten. ABSTRAK

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Penelitian ini menganalisa salah satu dari puisi Emily Dickinson berjudul *I died for beauty, but was scarce*, yang merupakan puisi berkabung tentang kematian. Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk mencari personifikasi dari kematian dan arti dari personifikasi secara keseluruhan di puisi *I died for beauty, but was scarce*. Dalam penelitian ini, peneliti membuat dua rumusan masalah, yaitu: “Personifikasi kematian apakah yang dapat ditemukan di puisi *I died for beauty, but was scarce*?” dan “Apakah arti dari personifikasi kematian secara keseluruhan yang ditemukan dalam puisi *I died for beauty, but was scarce*? ”

Dalam mengumpulkan data, peneliti menggunakan penelitian kepustakaan. Pendekatan formalis dirasa sesuai untuk menganalisa masalah-masalah tersebut bersamaan dengan teori-teori lain yang digunakan. Seseorang yang meninggal akan diingat untuk beberapa saat oleh saudara, keluarga, atau orang-orang yang mengenalnya. Akan tetapi, pada akhirnya, mereka akan dilupakan. Terlebih lagi, tujuan hidup mereka tidak akan berguna jika seseorang telah meninggal. Oleh karena itu, kematian dapat dipertimbangkan sebagai kegagalan. Dalam puisi ini, seseorang yang telah meninggal demi kebenaran dan seseorang yang telah mati demi keindahan berakhir dalam posisi dan tempat yang sama. Bahkan, kematian membuat kita sama, jalani hidup yang berharga dan milikilah tujuan yang baik bagi dirimu dan orang lain.
