

## ABSTRAK

Mali, Kristorius Bernaris.2022. *Implikatur Percakapan Antartokoh dalam Kitab Suci Injil Matius Bab 1 – Bab 14.* Skripsi. Yogyakarta. Program Studi Pendidikan Bahasa dan Sastra Indonesia, Fakultas Keguruan dan Ilmu Pendidikan, Universitas Sanata Dharma.

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk memberikan jawaban terhadap dua buah persoalan yakni yang pertama, mengenai jenis-jenis implikatur percakapan antartokoh dalam Kitab Suci injil Matius bab 1 – bab 14, serta yang kedua, mengenai maksud implikatur percakapan antartokoh dalam Kitab Suci injil Matius bab 1 – bab 14. Objek dari penelitian ini adalah Kitab Suci khususnya injil Matius bab 1 – bab 14. Data yang diambil berupa tuturan para tokoh dalam injil Matius bab 1 – bab 14.

Jenis penelitian yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah penelitian deskriptif kualitatif. Metode yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah metode kajian pustaka dengan teknik baca dan catat. Proses pengumpulan data pada penelitian ini melalui beberapa tahapan antara lain tahap mengidentifikasi data, menginventarisasi data, mengkategorisasi data, menginterpretasi data, serta tahap menyampaikan hasil analisis data.

Hasil yang diperoleh dalam penelitian ini adalah yang pertama, jenis-jenis implikatur percakapan antartokoh dalam Kitab Suci injil Matius bab 1 - bab 14 yakni peneliti menemukan tiga jenis implikatur percakapan yang terdiri dari implikatur percakapan umum (IPU), implikatur percakapan khusus (IPK), dan implikatur percakapan berskala (IPB). Kedua, maksud implikatur percakapan antartokoh dalam Kitab Suci Injil Matius bab 1 - bab 14, yakni peneliti menemukan 14 maksud implikatur percakapan yang berupa: maksud menasehati, maksud memerintah, maksud menyatakan, maksud memohon, maksud berbelasungkawa, maksud mengeluh, maksud mengklaim, maksud memuji, maksud berterima kasih, maksud berjanji, maksud menyalahkan, maksud menyarankan, maksud merekomendasikan, serta maksud memberi nama.

## ABSTRACT

*This study aims to provide answers to two questions, namely the first, regarding the types of conversational implicatures between characters in the Scriptures of the Gospel of Matthew chapters 1 – chapter 14, and the second, regarding the meaning of conversational implicatures between characters in the Scriptures of the Gospel of Matthew chapters 1 – chapters 14. The object of this research is the Holy Scriptures, especially the Gospel of Matthew chapters 1 – chapter 14. The data taken are the speeches of the characters in the Gospel of Matthew chapters 1 – chapter 14.*

*The type of research used in this research is descriptive qualitative research. The method used in this study is a literature review method with reading and note-taking techniques. The process of collecting data in this study went through several stages, including the stage of identifying data, taking an inventory of data, categorizing data, interpreting data, and conveying the results of data analysis.*

*The results obtained in this study are first, the types of conversational implicatures between characters in the Holy Bible Gospel of Matthew chapters 1 - chapter 14, namely the researchers found three types of conversational implicatures consisting of general conversational implicatures,, special conversational implicatures, and scaled conversational implicatures. Second, the meaning of conversational implicatures between characters in the Holy Scriptures of the Gospel of Matthew chapter 1 - chapter 14, namely the researchers found 14 conversational implicatures in the form of: the meaning of advising, the meaning of commanding, the meaning of stating, the meaning of pleading, the meaning of condolences, the meaning of complaining, the meaning of claiming, the meaning of praising . , meaning to thank, meaning to promise, meaning to blame, meaning to suggest, meaning to recommend, and meaning to name.*
