

**HUBUNGAN ANTARA *HELICOPTER PARENTING* DENGAN  
PLAGIARISME PADA GENERASI Z DENGAN *PERFORMANCE  
ORIENTATION* SEBAGAI VARIABEL MEDIASI**

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**ABSTRAK**

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan antara *helicopter parenting* dengan sikap terhadap plagiarisme pada generasi Z, dan apakah hubungan tersebut dimediasi oleh *performance goal orientation*. Subjek dari penelitian ini merupakan 545 mahasiswa generasi Z dengan rentang umur dari 17 hingga 27 tahun. Alat pengumpulan data yang digunakan adalah *Attitudes Toward Plagiarism Questionnaire - Revised (ATPQ-R)*, *Achievement Goal Questionnaire – Revised (AGQ-R)*, dan *Helicopter Parenting Instrument (HPI)*. Sebelum digunakan, ketiga skala diadaptasi ke Bahasa Indonesia melalui proses *back-translation*. Skala *ATPQ-R* terdiri dari 20 item dengan nilai reliabilitas 0,925. Skala *AGQ-R* terdiri dari 12 item dengan nilai reliabilitas 0,763. Skala *HPI* terdiri dari 12 item dengan nilai reliabilitas 0,862. Uji validitas juga dilakukan dengan metode *expert judgement* oleh dosen pembimbing peneliti, dengan hasil seluruh item memiliki validitas yang baik. Uji hipotesis menggunakan analisis regresi berganda dan *bootstrapping* dengan makro PROCESS v4.1. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan terdapat hubungan yang positif dan signifikan antara variabel *helicopter parenting* dengan sikap terhadap plagiarisme pada generasi Z, hubungan tersebut juga dimediasi secara signifikan oleh orientasi *performance avoidance goal*. Berarti, semakin tinggi tingkat *helicopter parenting* yang dialami individu, maka individu akan cenderung memiliki orientasi *performance avoidance*, sehingga membuat individu semakin bersikap toleran terhadap plagiarisme.

**THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN HELICOPTER PARENTING AND  
PLAGIARISM IN GENERATION Z WITH PERFORMANCE  
ORIENTATION AS A MEDIATION VARIABLE**

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**ABSTRACT**

This study aims to determine the relationship between helicopter parenting style and plagiarism in Generation Z, and whether the relationship is mediated by performance goal orientation. The subjects in this study are 545 generation Z which ranged in age from 17 to 27 years. Data collection scale used are Attitudes Toward Plagiarism Questionnaire-Revised (ATPQ-R), Achievement Goal Questionnaire-Revised (AGQ-R), and Helicopter Parenting Instrument (HPI). Before being used, the three scales were adapted to Indonesian through a back-translation process. The ATPQ-R scale consists of 20 items with a reliability value of 0.925. The AGQ-R scale consists of 12 items with a reliability value of 0.763. The HPI scale consists of 12 items with a reliability value of 0.862. A validity test was also carried out using the expert judgment method by the researcher supervisor, showing that all items had good validity. Hypothesis are tested using multiple linear regression and bootstrapping method with PROCESS v4.1 macro. The results showed that there was a positive and significant relationship between helicopter parenting and attitudes towards plagiarism in Generation Z, the relationship was also significantly mediated by the orientation of performance-avoidance goals. It means, that the higher the helicopter parenting level experienced by the individual, the individual will tend to have a performance-avoidance orientation, thus making the individual more tolerate plagiarism.
